Ljubica Tasic obtained her bachelor's and Master's in Chemistry from the Faculty of Chemistry, Belgrade University (Belgrade, Serbia) in 94. After a four-year experience as an Assistant Professor in the Applied Chemistry Department (Faculty of Chemistry, Belgrade) and MSc in Chemistry (1998), she continued her graduated studies at the Chemistry Institute of the University of Campinas (Unicamp, Campinas, Brazil), where obtained PhD in May 02. Post-doctorate research, from August 02 to May 04, she carried out at the National Synchrotron Light Laboratory (Brazil). Since October 04, as Professor at the Organic Chemistry Department of the Chemistry Institute (Unicamp, Brazil), she lectures courses on Organic Chemistry, General Chemistry and Biochemistry. Her research projects are related to Biological Chemistry, Biochemistry, Nanochemistry and Metabolomics. At the moment, she is an Associate Professor at Organic Chemistry Department (Unicamp, Campinas, Brazil). She is author of more than 75 scientific articles, she also published around 20 book chapters and deposited five patents (Brazilian Agency) and one international patent.
